

2019 10U East & 11U-70' STATE TOURNAMENT TEAM SKILLS CONTEST

ALL PLAYERS ON YOUR ROSTER MUST PARTICIPATE. NO PLAYER CAN DO MORE THAN 1 EVENT, (UNLESS SPECIFICALLY INDICATED IN THE RULES BELOW)!

EVENTS

- 1. THROWING AROUND THE HORN {HOME TO 3RD TO 2ND TO 1ST BACK TO HOME} THIS WILL BE A TIMED EVENT ONE TIME AROUND THE BASES; FASTEST TEAM WINS. EACH PLAYER MUST START THE COMPETITION TOUCHING THEIR RESPECTIVE BASE/PLATE. (TOTAL OF 4 PLAYERS)
- 2. RUNNING THE BASES. EACH TEAM WILL HAVE 4 PLAYERS RUN 1 TIME AROUND BASES FROM HOME TO HOME. FOR EACH BASED MISSED, A 5 SECOND PENALTY WILL BE ADDED TO THE TEAM TIME. EACH PLAYER WILL RUN WITH A BASEBALL IN THEIR HAND, AND MUST TRANSFER THE BASEBALL TO THE NEXT RUNNER AT HOME. THIS IS A RELAY RACE; FASTEST TEAM WINS. (TOTAL OF 4 PLAYERS)
- 3. THROWING CONTEST FROM CENTER FIELD TO HOME. A TARGET WILL BE SETUP AT HOME. 3 POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR A BALL GOING INTO THE TARGET, 1 POINT AWARDED FOR A BALL TOUCHING THE TARGET, AND 0 POINTS FOR AN ERRANT THROW. EACH PLAYER WILL THROW 2 BALLS. THIS POINT SYSTEM WILL SIMPLY BE USED TO DETERMINE THE TEAM SCORE PER THE DIRECTIONS BELOW. (TOTAL OF 4 PLAYERS)

SCORING

- 1. EACH TEAM WILL BE RANKED FROM 1 THRU # OF TEAMS IN <u>EACH</u> EVENT (ASSUME 9 TEAMS FOR EXAMPLE). 1^{ST} PLACE WILL BE WORTH 9 POINTS, 2^{ND} WORTH 8 POINTS AND SO ON TO 9^{TH} BEING WORTH 1 POINT.
- 2. ALL EVENTS WILL BE COMBINED AND THE TEAM WITH THE MOST POINTS WILL BE THE SKILLS CHAMPION. THERE WILL NOT BE INVIDIUAL WINNERS JUST A TEAM CHAMPION.
- 3. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE IN AN INDIVIDUAL EVENT, BOTH TEAMS WILL BE AWARDED POINTS BASED UPON THE "TIE" RANKING; (I.E. IF TWO TEAMS TIE FOR 2ND PLACE, THEY WILL BOTH BE AWARDED 8 POINTS).
- 4. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE AT THE END OF THE CONTEST, THE TIE WILL BE BROKEN BY REVERTING BACK TO THE AROUND THE HORN EVENT (#1 ABOVE), WITH THE SAME FOUR PLAYERS THAT ORIGINALLY COMPETED IN THAT EVENT. THE FASTEST NEW TIME WILL DETERMINE THE COMPETITION WINNER.

PRIZES

PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE CHAMPION TEAM.
